Brief Overview:

4. Additional Resources:

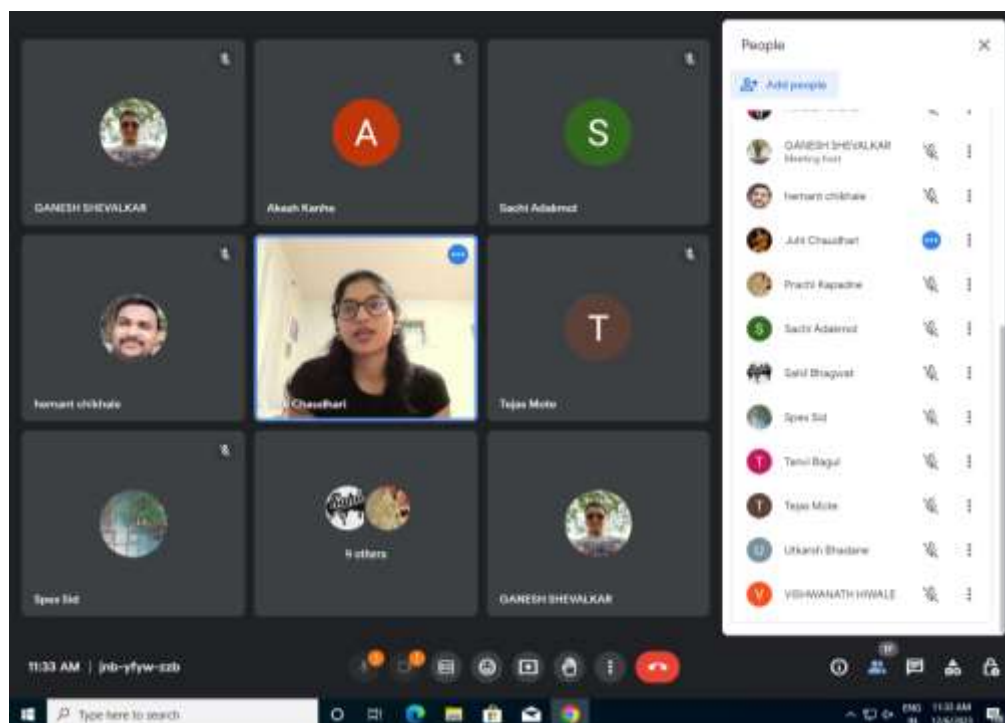
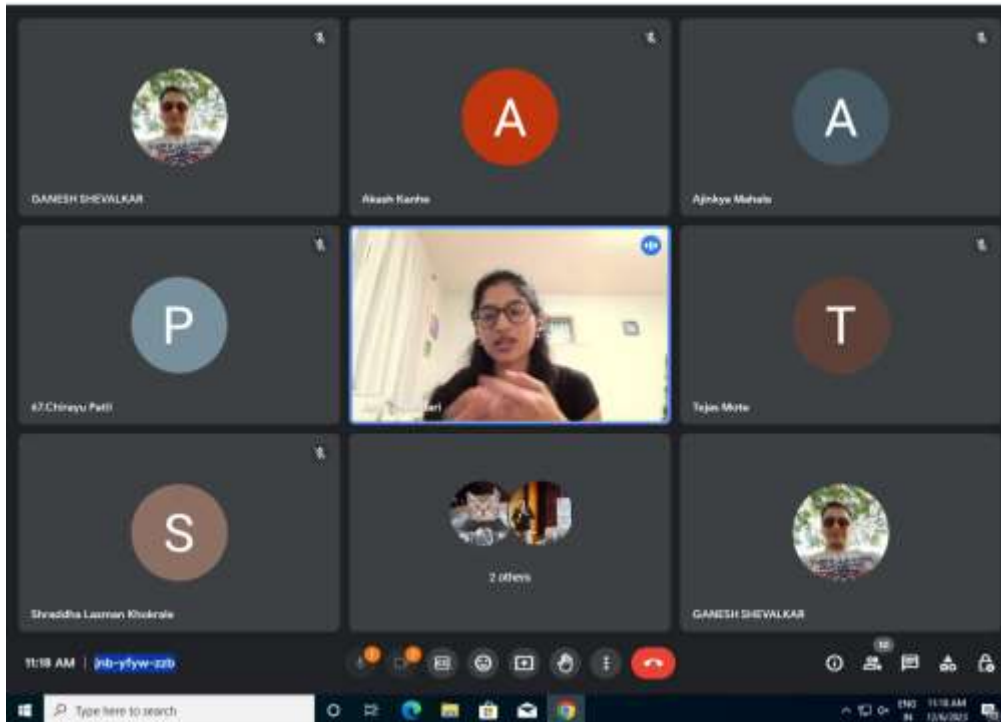
- Recommendations for additional resources, including online platforms, study groups, and tutoring services, were shared to aid participants in their preparation journey.
- Strategies for leveraging online resources effectively to supplement study materials were provided.

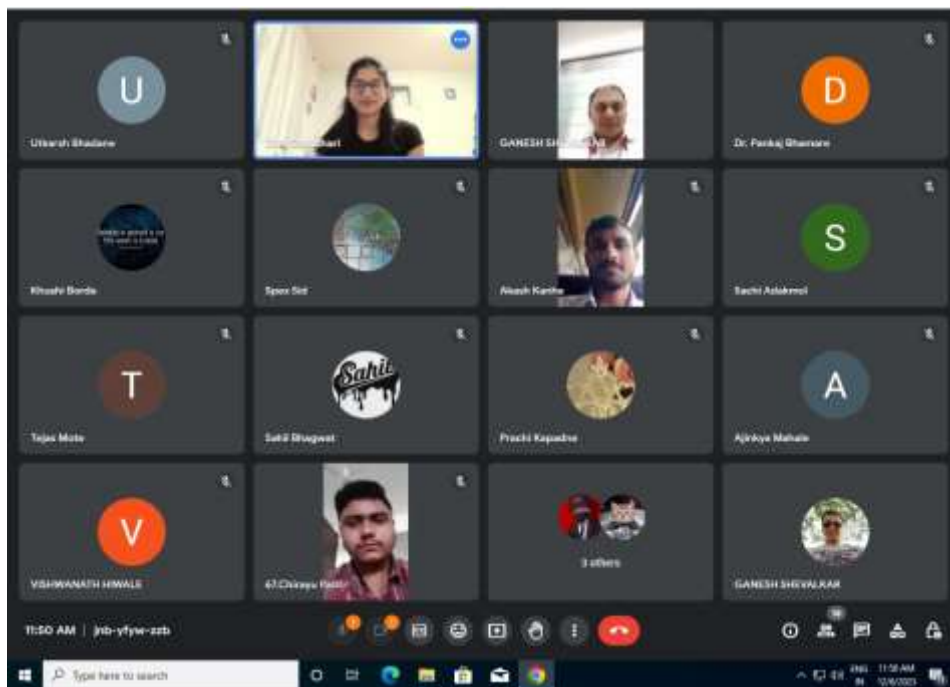
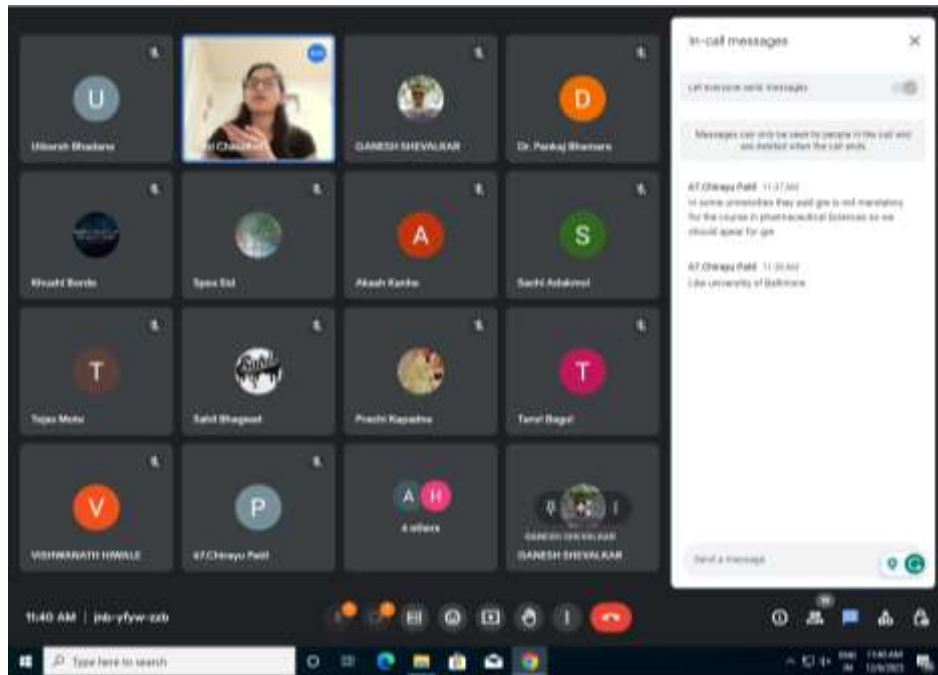
Conclusion:
