Details of the event:

Under the guidance of Col. Arun Jha sir Sandip Foundation and Sandip University jointly organized the intercollege competition VIBRANCE.

The main objective of the competition was to enhance the awareness of soft skills among the students.

Students in their final year participated in the event. A total of twelve teams from Sandip Foundation & Sandip University participated in the competition. Each team comprised of 10 participants.

Competition conducted in three modalities i.e.

- ✓ Essay Writing
- ✓ Group Discussion
- ✓ Extempore speech

Event began sharply at 10:30 am. In **Essay Writing** all ten participants were involved from each team where they had to write an essay comprising a minimum of 250 words on a given topic "East or West Nashik is the best".
