In India Every year "National Sports Day" is celebrated on 29th of August on the Birth anniversary of Major Dhyan Chand Major Dhyan Chand was an Indian field hockey player, regarded by many as the greatest field hockey player in history. He was known for his extraordinary ball control and goal-scoring feats, in addition to earning three Olympic gold medals, in 1928, 1932 and 1936, during an era where India dominated field hockey. On 29th August 2023 Tuesday, Sandip Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Mahiravani, Nashik

celebrated "National Sports Day". The program began with a lamp lighting ceremony. Principal Dr. L.B. Borse sir addressed to staff and students about the importance of Sports in our life. Principal Dr.Laxmikant B.Borse has told Biography of Major Dhyan Chand he is called the "Hockey Wizard" due to his excellent control over the ball. Major Dhyan Chand announced his retirement from hockey in the year 1948. He had scored more than 400 goals in his international career. The Government of India awarded him the Padma Bhushan, the third-highest civilian honour, in the year 1956. Sutherland was known in the 20th century as the "Father of Hockey" for his tireless work administering and promoting the game. The native of Kingston, Ontario, was born in 1870, three years after the birth of Canada as a nation. With three Olympic gold medals, he was the poster boy of Indian hockey for decades. Dhyan Chand's birthday is celebrated as National Sports Day in India. For many, Dhyan Chand is simply the greatest Indian field hockey player of all time. So,that the student understands the importance of sports has the power to improve your strength and Physical Fitness.
